DANGER

CAUTION

- USE preventative cleaning measures to keep your stone pristine.
- USE sealers according to the product specific directions.
- Blot spills quickly, and wash with mild soap and warm water.
- □ Stone countertops (Granite, Marble, etc.) are surprisingly resilient to stains and scratches. However, as a preventative measure, any spills on the stone surfaces should be wiped up within a reasonable amount of time. Don't let liquid sit on the stone overnight. Stones are most prone to staining by oil and acid, so be sure to blot these spills up as soon as they happen. Follow up by cleaning the stone with a mild non-abrasive soap and water.
- Be sure to check all packing materials carefully for small parts that may have come loose inside the carton during shipment. If parts are missing, contact THE HOME DEPOT to obtain any missing parts.
- Using abrasive cleansers will damage the surface.

PLANNING INSTALLATION


Check the vanity for damage before installation. If any part of the vanity is missing or damaged, contact the Customer Service Team at 1-800-986-3460.

Ensure that the vanity location is accessible to water supply and drain lines. It is recommend that you rough-in the water lines and drain before installing the vanity.




NOTE: A drain pipe and trap are not included with this vanity.


VANITY AND COUNTERTOP DIMENSIONS





Installation - [1 Wall Hanging]


1 Finding studs

- Use a stud finder to find edges of wood and locate the center.
- The top and bottom solid wood hanging cleat must screw into at least 2 wood studs or more.




2 Installing the wall hanging cleats

- Use a pencil to mark the installation for the cleats (D, E). use a level to ensure the cleats (D, E) will be level before installing to the wall.
- Install the twelve anchors (EE) provided into the wall the wall as shown in the diagram. If necessary, pre-drill the anchor holes using a drill.
- With the beveled edges facing up, the two wall hanging cleats (D, E) to the wall using the twelve screws (FF) provided.
- Must identify (D) and (E) positions before installing




3 Hanging the vanity


With help from another person, carefully hang the vanity (B) onto the wall hanging cleats.



4 Installing the backsplash

- □ Apply silicone to the back of the backsplash (A)
- □ Place the backslash (A) onto the vanity (B). Be sure to align the backsplash (A) with the top of vanity (B).
- Allow the silicone to dry before using the vanity.






Installation - [2 Free Standing]


1 Installing iron stand

- □ Place the metal stand (J) onto the floor.
- □ Take the metal tubes (F), (G), (H), (I) and insert the tubes on to the protruding ends of the stand. (Make sure the lock points are facing inwards to each other).
- □ Note: Please ensure that the legs and stand are parallel to each other.




2 Installing iron feet

- Insert and tighten the screws (CC) in the corresponding holes on the metal legs and tighten. (Please ensure that the legs and stand are parallel to each other).
- Place the other metal stand (K) onto to the opposing side of the metal legs.




3 Locking iron feet

Insert and tighten the other screws (CC) in to the holes of the metal stand. (Please ensure that the legs and stand are parallel to each other).



4 Installing wooden board


- □ Place the wooden board (C) onto top/over the protruding ends.
- Insert and tighten the screws (DD) into the insertion point.



Installation - [2 Free Standing]


5 Adjusting the levelers


□ Insert the levelers (AA) into the ends of the of the metal stand. (Please ensure that the levelers are screwed in tightly).



6 Merge sink and iron feet


- Place the vanity onto top of the metal stand. (Please make sure that the corners of the vanity and metal stand are placed right on top of each other)
- □ Place the vanity (B) onto the metal stand.
- Insert and tighten the screws (CC) into the corresponding insertion holes and tighten.






7 Installing the backsplash

- □ Apply silicone to the back of the backsplash (A)
- □ Place the backslash (A) onto the vanity (B). Be sure to align the backsplash (A) with the top of vanity (B).
- □ Allow the silicone to dry before using the vanity





Maintenance

- □ In the even that your furniture is stained or otherwise damaged during use, we recommend that you call a professional to repair your furniture.
- □ Check bolts/screws periodically and tighten them if necessary.

Care and Cleaning

- Rinse vanity top with clean, hot water frequently.
- □ Blot spills guickly, and wash with mild soap and warm water.
- Clean the surface with a glass cleaner or other household cleansers that are non-abrasive
- □ Remove oil-based stains with acetone, mineral spirits, or ammonia.
- □ Organic stains like coffee, tea, or juice can be removed with hydrogen peroxide, mixed with a few drops of ammonia
- □ Water spots or rings can be removed by buffing the spots gently with 00-gauge steel wool.
- Small nicks and scratches can often be removed the same way.
- Larger scratches, chips, and resilient stains may require professional help. Please contact your local stonemason for details.
- Use if you have Natural Stone Your stone was sealed at the factory, but reapplication is necessary over time. How often is determined by the quality of the sealer used, and the frequency of use. We recommend using a penetrating non-toxic sealer for bath areas.

Troubleshooting
