DVLA is an executive agency of the Department for Transport

Core Responsibility: collect duty and road safety.

Maintain over 48 million driver records and almost 40 million vehicle records.

Collects around £6 billion a year in Vehicle Excise Duty (VED).

Background

VED evasion has risen from **0.6%** to **1.8%** over a six year period



1.8% equates to a **potential loss** of **£107million** to the Exchequer



New national wheel-clamping contract began in February 2019



Local Authorities can support DVLA to tackle this with some clear benefits for you



Devolved Power Partners



Under legislation, the Secretary of State can Devolve DVLA enforcement powers to local authorities to help tackle Vehicle Excise Duty (VED) evasion.



DVLA and Local Authorities then work in partnership to remove unlicensed vehicles from the roads.



Local Authorities have an opportunity to raise income from fees and fines.



DVLA receive updated keeper details to update DVLA records which gives a positive impact to all who use this information.



Legislation



Vehicle Excise & Registration Act 1994 (VERA)

Vehicle Excise Duty 1997 (VED) Immobilisation, Removal and Disposal of Vehicles

If you Immobilise you cannot impound for 24 hours

Straight to impound within 30 minutes (if not immobilised)

After taking action you must inform DVLA the same day

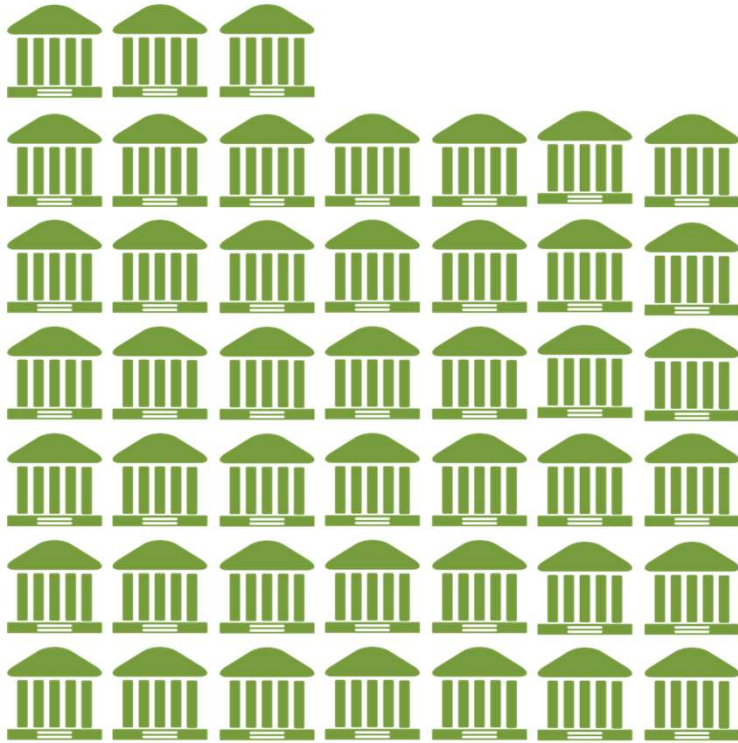
CLE2/6 Offence Report must be completed and sent to DVLA (5 days)

Disposal must be via auction or Authorised Treatment Facility (ATF)

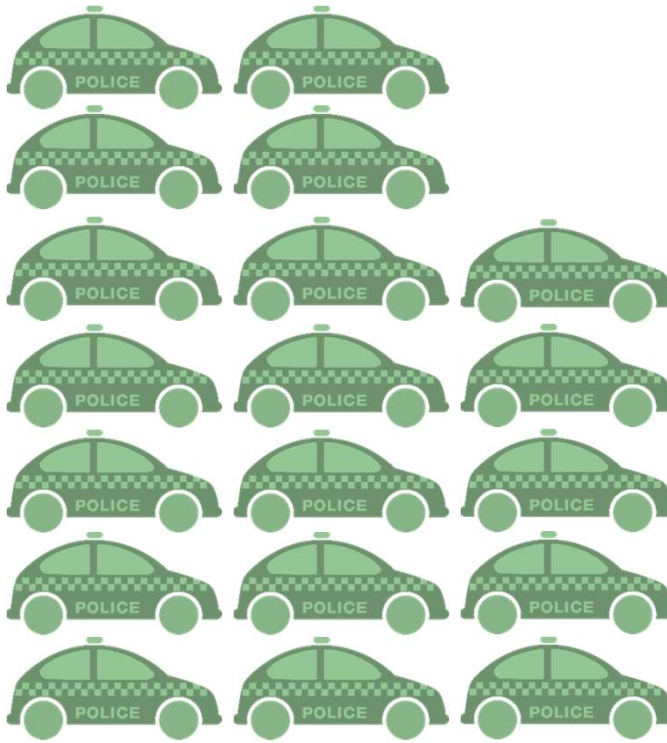

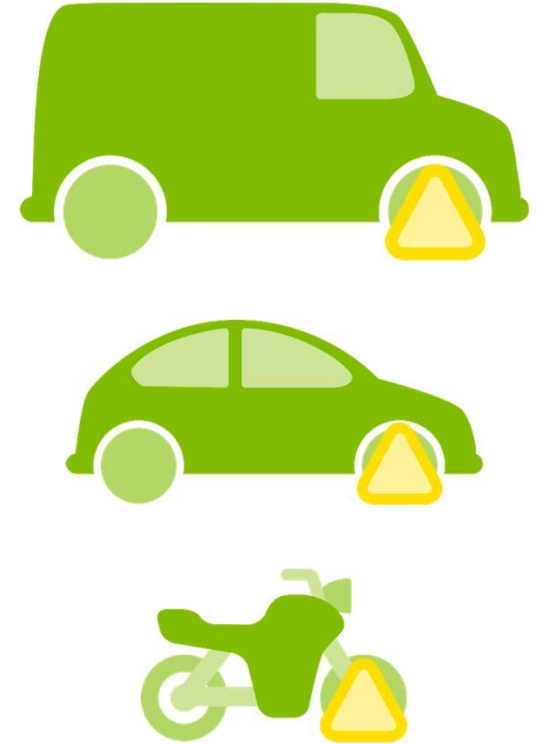

Benefits of taking on Devolved Powers



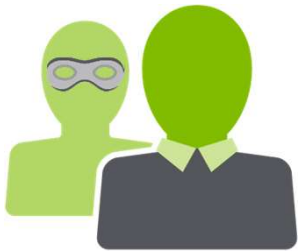
Improves the quality of local environments



Reduce incidents of vehicle arson



Disrupts criminality associated with the use of untaxed vehicles



Reduces the opportunity for anti-social behaviour



Encourages motorists to re-license their vehicles



Helps to maintain accuracy of DVLA's records – vital for DVLA and Local Authorities

Benefits of taking on Devolved Powers



Release fee of **£100**. Increasing to **£200** if not claimed within 24 hours.



Surety fee of **£160** if not claimed within 15 days



Any income from vehicle disposal



£21 per day storage fee
